Physical Disability

The Disabilities Trust's Disability Services are the means by which we provide specialist services for people with physical disabilities including cerebral palsy, muscular dystrophy, spina bifida, arthritis, stroke, multiple sclerosis and disabilities resulting from accidents.

As well as providing physical care, we are committed to ensuring people have independence and control over their lives and are treated with dignity and respect at all times. Needs are individually assessed, and care is delivered in a person-centred environment, either in a service user's own home or in a community or residential setting.
