Eastfields extension doubles the number of people with acquired brain injury who can be accommodated from 12 to 24 beds

About Eastfields:

Eastfields is part of the continuum of care provided by The Disabilities Trust in Scotland.

Eastfields opened in 2015 and is a registered Care Home for Adults delivering a health and social care model of support to individuals with an acquired or traumatic brain injury.

The Eastfields model of care has been very successful, and because there are few other providers of this brain injury rehabilitation model in Scotland, there is a high demand for this specialist service.

The service is set in secure landscaped gardens with disabled access footpaths, raised flower beds, trees and shrubs.

Eastfields is set back from Springburn Road with good transport links to Glasgow city centre.

Our service at a glance - what we can provide:

Three separate bungalows providing 24 beds as follows:

- Bluebell is an 8 bedded unit for individuals who have complex, challenging behaviour and nursing needs, who require a specialist quality long term environment. Bluebell has 24-hour nursing provision alongside a high staff to service user ratio.
- Hawthorn has 8 self-contained studio flats offering individuals the opportunity to reach their full potential in regaining their independence through on-going vocational and clinical input, and psychological and behavioural management. It offers long term placements but also provide the potential for individuals to transition into their own tenancy within the community or to return home to live with their family.
- Thistle has 4 self-contained flats and 4 large bedrooms designed for long stay service users.



Hawthorn and Thistle Units

8 self-contained flats and an 8 bedded transitional living service

Designed for people who:

- display high risk behaviours
- are physically high functioning
- require on-going psychological and behavioural management
- have the potential to transition into their own tenancy following this support
- may require long term support
- have difficulty managing their behaviour
- have cognitive impairment
- require on-going vocational and clinical input
- would benefit from a structured day and meaningful activities.

To help service users to increase independence prior to discharge; offering an opportunity to ensure that people are able to manage independently or to determine what support is required when they return home.

Bluebell Unit

8 bedded nursing service

- meet criteria for NHS continuing care
- cannot be cared for in standard nursing homes
- have complex medical needs
- display behaviours that challenge the service provider
- may require reactive clinical team input.
